

37th World Scout and Guide Collectors Meeting and 12th EuroScout

Introduction

This event combines two major international activities related to the collection of Scout themes: the "37th World Scout and Guide Collectors Meeting", for collectors of all types of objects related to Scouts and Guides, and "12th EuroScout", a philatelic meeting of Scout and Guide stamps. This is the second time that the world meeting takes place in Portugal. The terms of participation reflect what has been usual in previous editions of these two activities.

Registration

The registration fee for each participant (exhibitor) is € 40, and includes:

- 37th World Collectors Meeting Badge
- 12th EuroScout Badge
- Participant's Badge (exhibitor)
- Official Dinner (Saturday)

- Exhibitor Diploma
- Table (1 meter)
- Guided tour to historical center of Évora

Note 1: Registration fee does not include: meals in addition to Saturday dinner, accommodation in a hotel unit.

Note 2: CPCOE members are guaranteed a 25% discount on the cost of registration.

Note 3: The accompanying participants (exhibitors) pay only the cost of Saturday dinner, in the amount of € 15, if they wish to participate in it.

Tables and Frames

Only for participants (exhibitors), one or more extra tables can be facilitated, subject to availability, with a payment of 8 € for each extra table.

The organization of the event reserves the right to reduce the number of tables / desks requested, due to the space available for exhibition and the total number of tables enrolled, so that there may be a need for apportionment.

Collections

The organization will not accept the sending of collections by mail. They must be transported in person by the participant or his agent.

The organization of the event assumes no responsibility for losses or damages that may occur in any of the exhibits, before, during and after the meeting / exhibition, and it is the responsibility of the participants, if they wish, to carry out insurance for the collection(s) in order to guarantee any damages or losses.

The organization will make every effort to ensure that adequate measures are in place to monitor and care for exposed materials.

Application Validation

Registration is considered valid only after:

- completing the registration form, and
- full payment of the registration fee.

Application deadline

- The cost of 40 € is valid for registrations made until 04 March 2018.
- In case the registration is made after March 4 and until March 30, the cost has a worsening of 10 €, that is, it will have a value of 50 €.
- In case the registration is made after 30 March and until 30 April, the cost has a worsening of 20 €, that is, it will have a value of 60 €.

Withdrawals:

- • Until March 31, 2018 - 50% return
- • After 31-March-2018 - There is no right to return
